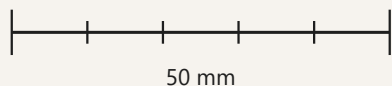


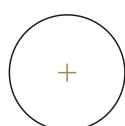
Printable ring sizer



Print this page at actual size or 100 %, not "Fit to page". Then measure the line on the left – it must be exactly 5 cm long.

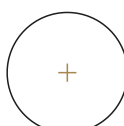
1. With a ring that fits

Place the ring on the circles. The right size is the circle whose line sits exactly on the inner edge of the ring. If it falls between two circles, choose the larger one.



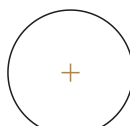

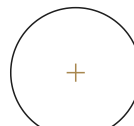

2. With the measuring strip

1. Cut out the strip along the dashed line.
2. Wrap it around your finger where the ring will sit – it must still fit over the knuckle. Don't pull too tight.
3. The number where the start (▲) meets the strip is your ring size.



Good to know

Measure in the evening with warm hands – that is when fingers are at their fullest. For wide rings from about 6 mm, go half a size up.
